The First Vaccine: Smallpox or Cow Pox, 1802










Smallpox Vaccine Causes Syphilis?















Herd Immunity: Public Health is Not My Problem









Correlation Does Not Equal Causation

Multiple vaccine doses have resulted in up to 145,000 child deaths in past 20 years

According to data compiled from the government's Vaccine Adverse Events Reporting System (VAERS), as many as 145,000 children or more have died in the past 20 years as a result of this multiple vaccine dose approach, and few parents are aware of this shocking fact.







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Vaccine Myths: Summary

- 1. Vaccines can cause the disease they are trying to prevent.
- 2. Vaccines can cause additional diseases and health problems.
- 3. Vaccines are unnecessary; illness is not to be taken seriously.
- 4. Vaccines are a widespread cause of death.





Vaccine Myths: Root Causes

- Fear of the unknown
- Minimizing/dismissing threats of disease
- Only those with weak moral and physical character get sick
- Short collective memories
- Mistrust of authority, intellectuals
- Misunderstanding data
- Groupthink
- Lack of social connection/access to education and money

COVID-19 Vaccines





COVID-19 Vaccines Licensed and Available in the U.S.

Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)

- Moderna
- Pfizer-BioNTech
- Johnson & Johnson's (J&J) Janssen

U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approved vaccines:

- Comirnaty (generic: Pfizer-BioNTech)
- Spikevax (generic: Moderna)
- Janssen (generic: Johnson & Johnson's (J&J) Janssen)




COVID-19 Unvaccinated Risk

Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System (VAERS)





What is VAERS?

VAERS = Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System

- Subset of CDC WONDER (U.S. Reporting Data Access website)
- National early warning system.
- Possible side effects following vaccination.
- Not designed to detect if a vaccine caused an adverse event.
- Can identify unusual or unexpected patterns of reporting.
- Might indicate possible safety problems requiring a closer look.
- Examples





VAERS Managing Agencies

Co-administered:

- CDC
- FDA
- Agencies of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS)



VAERS Strengths

- CDC WONDER collects national data from all U.S. states and territories.
- Accepts reports from anyone.
- Data collection includes information about the vaccine, the person vaccinated and the adverse event.
- Data are publicly available.
- Matches a specific identifying number with each report for follow-up.
- Fraudulent claims identified by the CDC and FDA can have legal consequences.





VAERS Limitations

- Cannot determine if the vaccine caused the reported adverse event.
- Publicly available data from CDC WONDER caused confusion, specifically regarding the number of reported deaths.
- Instances where people have misinterpreted reports of deaths following vaccination as deaths caused by the vaccines; that is not accurate.
- VAERS accepts all reports of adverse health events following vaccinations without judging whether the vaccine caused the adverse health event.
- Some reports to VAERS represent true vaccine reactions and others are coincidental adverse health events and not related to vaccination.
- Overall, a causal relationship cannot be established using information from VAERS report alone.

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VAERS Limitations Continued

- Submitted reports often lack details and sometimes contains errors.
- Serious adverse events are more likely to be reported than non-serious events.
- Numbers of reports may increase in response to media attention and increased public awareness.
- VAERS data cannot be used to determine rates of adverse events (multiple reports of same adverse event or missing adverse events).
- No way of knowing if vaccines cause any adverse events using VAERS alone.

Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System

- 1. Have you had a reaction following a vaccination?
- 2. Contact your health care provider.
- 3. New: report an Adverse Event using the <u>VAERS online form</u> or the downloadable PDF.
- 4. Important: if you are experiencing a medical emergency, seek immediate assistance from a health care provider or call 9-1-1. CDC and FDA do not provide individual medical treatment, advice or diagnosis. If you need individual medical or health care advice, consult a qualified health care provider.

VAERS Provider Reporting

Legal requirements for providers VAERS reporting:

- Any adverse event listed in the <u>VAERS Table of Reportable</u> <u>Events Following Vaccination</u> that occurs within the specified time period after vaccination.
- Adverse event listed by the vaccine manufacturer as a contraindication to further doses of the vaccine.





VAERS Provider Reporting

Strongly encouraged provider VAERS reporting:

- Any adverse event that occurs after the administration of a vaccine licensed in the U.S., whether or not it is clear a vaccine caused the adverse event.
- Vaccine administration errors.
- Vaccine manufacturers are required to report ALL adverse events that come to their attention.


Clinical Immunization Safety Assessment (CISA) Project

- CDC established in 2001.
- Provides a comprehensive vaccine safety public health service to the nation.
- Addresses the unmet vaccine safety clinical research needs of the U.S.
- National network of vaccine safety experts including:
 - Immunization Safety Office (ISO), part of CDC
 - Seven medical research centers
 - Additional partners






CISA Reporting Partners

Vaccine Injury Compensation Program (VICP)

- Separate program from VAERS and CISA.
- Administered by the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA).
- Reporting an adverse event to VAERS does not constitute filing a claim with the VICP.
